



The M.Sc. Advisor

The Department requires that all M.Sc. students have an Advisor/Counsellor during their program, in addition to the Supervisor of the Thesis. The following may assist you in making this arrangement.

- How:** To be selected by the student, in consultation with the primary thesis supervisor, within the first 3 months of initial registration.
- WHO:** Usually a professor within Pharmacology.
Graduate Faculty Member.

- WHY:** To facilitate the student's program.
To provide advice on the research project, if needed.
Someone for the student to talk to if any work or interpersonal problems arise.
- ROLE:** Availability if needed.
Regular interviews with student.

An Advisor Report must be received in the Graduate Office before the student is allowed to re-register in September.
