M.Sc. PROGRAM ADVISOR SELECTION

The MSc Advisor must be a Pharmacology Graduate Faculty member and must be selected **within three (3) months of registering** in the program by the student in consultation with the Supervisor. Advisors are subject to the approval of the Graduate Coordinator.

The role of the Advisor is to provide assistance and guidance to the student. In addition, the Advisor observes the progress of the student's academic and research program. It is desirable if the Advisor is available to help the student work out problems which the student is unable to discuss with the Supervisor. The Graduate Education Committee of the Department requires the submission of one report per year from the Advisor of each MSc student prior to reregistration.

The Supervisor, the Advisor, a member of the Supervisory Committee, or the student, may report problems directly to the Graduate Coordinator or the Department Chair.
